Judy Gonsalves is Division President, Chubb Bermuda. Ms. Gonsalves has executive operating responsibility for the Bermuda-based commercial property and casualty (P&C) insurance business that writes high-limit excess liability, property, directors and officers, and political risk coverage worldwide. In addition, she leads all strategies around production, product development and management, and profit and loss performance for Chubb Bermuda.

Ms. Gonsalves has 30 years of insurance industry experience. Before her current role, she served as Executive Vice President and Chief Underwriting Officer of Chubb Bermuda from 2010 to 2018. Ms. Gonsalves joined the company in 1992 as an Assistant Underwriter in the excess liability department. In 2004, she was appointed Senior Vice President, assuming product line management responsibility for ACE Bermuda and ACE Bermuda International's catastrophe excess liability portfolio. She was promoted to Executive Vice President in April 2010 and named Vice President, Chubb Group in October 2018.

Before joining the company, Ms. Gonsalves began her insurance career in the Risk Management department of the Captive Reinsurance division of American International Group (AIG) in Bermuda.
